

Nazish's trip to Pakistan

I first met Suzanne two years ago and shared our vision and burden for the lost. She then made her mind to go to Pakistan. We also discussed a possibility of her book *Dare to enter His presence* to be translated and published in Urdu, a language widely used across the Indian sub-continent.

About three months ago I had a message from Suzanne whether I had finished the translation of the book. You may be surprised to know that I had only started to work on the translation. She also told me that she has been given a contact in Pakistan by Eurovision and she was to go in mid February. I then had a challenge to finish the book. We planned our trip to Pakistan according to the dates which Suzanne had already accepted. We had a team of committed Christian pastors and evangelists in Sialkot northeast of Pakistan whom Nazish already knew and had worked with them. So we gave each party five days. We planned to spend the first half of our trip in Sialkot and the second in Lahore 125 km in the south.

Politically it did not seem to be the right time to go to Pakistan but our LORD is out of time and space. He knew we were going for Him and He paved the way by the forerunning of His Holy Spirit. We had three packed meetings a day. Hundreds saved everyday. In every meeting people were healed from all sorts of ailments and sicknesses. 4 deaf and dumb in two different meetings two at a time received their hearing and speech for the very first time in their lives. Lamé walked and danced, bad chests were healed, asthmas disappeared and so many other sicknesses miraculously disappeared in the mighty name of Jesus!

Every meeting was very special however one particular meeting I can never forget in my life. We were in a village church where the church building could only take about three hundred people on the floor. To our surprise there were six to eight hundred people, some of them were standing outside, sitting in the courtyard, hanging onto the boundary walls and some were standing in streets. There was a powerful presence of the Holy Spirit throughout the meeting. At the end of the message when we prayed for the sick many were healed instantly and the joy was ecstatic. The choir started a praise song and everyone was dancing. Meanwhile we were told that a Muslim wanted to get in to testify his healing. The streets, courtyards, alleyway and the church was so packed with people that it was hard for him to come to us. However people helped him to bring to us and he clearly announced his Muslim name telling in the microphone that he has been healed. The huge crowd gave a big hand for Jesus.
