Personal Letter By Suzanne Pillans.

Thank you to everyone who has helped in some way to make this work grow at such a fast rate. I believe that the Lord is increasing his anointing and speed of evangelism in these last days.

The visit to Uganda was most fruitful. Edward Kisembo has done a wonderful job of increase from having 2 bible schools to 36 bible schools in 1 year. This he did from living 4 hours away in the hills from Kampala, with the aid of an old motorbike.

Two months ago the Lord woke me one night and said to me 'Make Edward Kisembo the head over the work of Uganda'. 'Edward does not even have a vehicle' I answered. The Lord said 'Buy him one'. The next day £2,200 arrived in a cheque in the post for this need. This has never happened before so I knew what it was for. A land cruiser was then bought for the establishment of more bible schools in Uganda. This is already showing amazing results. I also met Patrick who travelled 3 days from Mombasa in Kenya. Patrick has a MA and wants to start a residential Step Out In Faith Bible School in Mombasa. He will now head up our bible school work in Kenya.

In Zambia we met Kelvin Shinga who runs a bible school near Lusaka and also Edwin Daka (MA) who runs a bible school 634 miles from Lusaka. Both pastors are doing a good job.

We were driven out to where the orphans were and dropped off, to be collected again a few days later. We stayed in a tiny village in 2 huts, Nicola and I in one and Hugh and Kelvin in the other, having to sleep on the floor.

It was dry and extremely hot and we met with the worst poverty. Only 41 of the orphans had already been rescued and 200 more joined us to hear the gospel of Jesus where every orphan received Christ. They then followed Nicola like the Pied Piper up to the village for a good feed. The chief sent his car to collect us to visit him the following day and we opened a further orphanage of 82 children and also a school and a church that same day.

We also visited the large school where we donated £100 for cement to get 2 snake riddled classrooms back into use and then we went to the clinic that only had three medicines available. We then showed the doctor how to pray for the lines of sick people, and the Lord healed the people who took Him seriously, and challenged the few that laughed at receiving healing in Jesus name.

Step Out In faith Uganda Report.

On 5th September 09. 12 Centres met in Kyamukooka Church. Local and government officials were present. Suzanne spoke on the gifts of the Holy Spirit and righteousness. The graduates were then anointed and then presented with their certificates. At 4.50pm the team were driven to Kibaala district.

6th September 09. The team graduated 2 bible schools in Kyentara church in the morning and 5 bible schools in Kisiita Centre in the afternoon.

The sick were also prayed for and some gave testimonies about their healing, ie heart diseases, broken ribs healed and other infirmities. We then drove until 2am to a hotel.

7th September 09. 4am start to drive to Kyamuribwa Masaka district when the land cruiser broke down. Hugh Bettles prayed that the Lord would show him the problem, when he noticed a broken wire. He then asked the Lord how to fix it with only pliers. The Lord did show Hugh. He fixed it with wire from one of the electrical mobile phone wires from our suitcase, and then made a clamp from a wire coat hanger and taped it with a plaster. We then drove off.

At Kyamuriba 2 bible schools graduated. Speeches were made by local authorities. After Suzanne's sermon the certificates were presented.

We then left for a long drive to Kakuuto centre in Rakav District to graduate another 5 bible schools that afternoon. After the sermon we awarded the certificates.

8th September 2009. We drove to Kitimbwa where Suzanne spoke to the 3 bible schools at Kayanga district that graduated and then drove to Munyonyo church in Kampala where the final bible school graduated.

Altogether 36 bible schools with 784 students were graduated over 6 areas of Uganda covering over 2,000 kilometres. We saw the move of God during the preaching of Rev Suzanne, people got healed and gave testimonies.

In the centres we visited they requested more teaching and bicycles to spread the gospel further.

We have in response opened a further 80 bible schools for 2010 with 3,670 students who have already applied.

36 more bicycles are urgently needed to make this possible.

The whole team are so grateful to the supporters of Suzanne's Ministries who have made the work possible.
