NEW WORK IN THE CONGO

Pastor Edward Kitembo heads up Step Out In Faith Ministries in Uganda, travelled to an area near the northern border of Uganda and Congo, where 70,000 families were located in the mountains. They have no schools, no churches, no medical care and the Gospel had not been preached to them.

He took with him 3 evangelists who were prepared to stay and work there planting churches and discipling the people.

The first village, Kisusu, the Gospel was preached and 340 came to the Lord and were baptised. The second village, Kyabisyer a days walk away, 443 came to the Lord and were baptised. The 3rd village Rubilia, 217 came to the Lord and were baptised. So in one week, 1,009 people came to the Lord and three new churches have begun. The people from the villages are asking us to begin schools there.

Rangiora Baptist Church in New Zealand provided the finance for the travel costs, goats for the evangelists, and clothes for the children who did not have any. A big Thank You.
