CONFERENCE IN SOUTHERN UGANDA

Once a year Pastor Edward runs a conference for previously trained pastors and evangelists so they can be encouraged in their work and have a fresh vision for the new year.

This year he invited 403 Pastors, but they each brought with them another 10 people from their churches, so 4,030 people turned up, along with 234 pastors from the surrounding districts and another 382 unsaved people as well. A total of 4,646 people.

This presented many challenges in the way of accommodation and food for the 5 days. Edward was not expecting this many to come. Two tents had to be hired, as well as rental accommodation found and many more cooks employed.

God spoke clearly to them that He wanted to extend the work they had all begun, and they needed to be ready for the great growth coming. So a fresh vision was given to them all.
