### INDIA FEB CRUSADE.

Enough salvations for 104 new Churches. Oxford Bible Church is sponsoring half costs for a second crusade in India 28 – 30 October. Please pray for the other half to come in as we step out in faith so that a further 100 Churches get planted.

### NEW ZEALAND AND AUSTRALIA.

each school,(sewing, soap making and a bakery), provide the daily needs like books, exam fees, clothes, chalk etc. This year we started a motor mechanics workshop and a internet cafe' to provide salaries for the teachers and cooks.

The great news is that within eleven months we now have all four schools self-sufficient. God gave the ideas, and He has brought this to divine completion. We are so thankful to Him.

### NEW BIBLE SCHOOLS IN BURUNDI, RWANDA AND TANZANIA. Supported from NZ.

Pastor Edward Kisembo went this year to Burundi to train 22 Bible School Teachers and a new work has begun with four Bible schools with 159 Pastors and students attending. At the same time Edward trained a further 10 Pastors from Rwanda as Bible School teachers and three new schools have opened in Rwanda with 79 Pastors and students doing Suzanne's evangelists Bible School course.

New Zealand has provided a sewing business for Burundi and a cooking business for Rwanda so the Directors can self-fund their Bible School work. In November 2012 Pastor Edward held a conference in Tanzania and as a result six new Bible Schools were opened with 246 students, plus two new churches opened. Edward taught them how to run a cooking business, but they need help in establishing this business.

With the new Bible Schools being able to self-fund themselves, this will be a tremendous help for the Ministry. All of the Bible Schools have a desperate need for bicycles for the pastors and Teachers who have to travel long distances to run the schools. A bicycle costs NZ \$100 or £55.

### ZAMBIA supported by New Zealand.

A wonderful gift from Ahava Love Ministry U.K. has enabled our Director, David Mtumbi, to purchase animals for the four orphan schools in Zambia. These animals, pigs, goats and chickens will become a means of self-funding wages for the teachers and cooks, as well as training the 2,000 orphans in animal care and business ventures. We hope to start some small businesses, in consultation with the committees, to enable the project to fully fund itself. This gives dignity to the people. Instead of having to have their hand out, it gives them a hand up.

A new tin roof for the school at Chapaleza means we no longer have to hire a building for the school there. Praise God.

The maize crop is now being harvested and should feed the children for at least 6 months with their staple food and the gardens are being planted with vegetables at this time.

### UGANDA supported by Australia and NZ.

Pastor Edward Kisembo started three new Churches in the Congo at the end of 2012, and this year we built a school at one of the villages, Kisu. This is the first school in the area, it has two teachers and has a roll of 248 pupils.

Another school and church was opened this year in Kibale, Uganda. It has three teachers, and already we have started organic gardens to feed the children.

We have been endeavouring to bring self-sufficiency to four other schools in Uganda which started last year. There are 1,200 attending and mostly they are aids orphans and some Pastors and evangelists children as well. The organic gardens are now feeding all the children at school, three small businesses at
