### *Teaching thought*

#### *"Unconditional surrender to God"*

This was the title for our last teaching and prayer weekend at the Ranch, deposited like a computer download in the prayer tabernacle, the evening before the weekend. I then realised that there are many levels of surrender which challenged me to another level.

The three items of furniture in the holy place deal with the soul. The showbread deals with our will, the candlestick with our mind and intellect and the table of incense with our emotions. Yielding these areas to God is one thing, but to what level? Part level, full level or unconditional level? Yielding is linked to obedience therefore unconditional yielding also means unconditional obedience.

The Lord loves us to the level of unconditional love that He went the whole way to the cross for us while we were still sinners. The more we yield and trust the Lord in obedience, the more He can do in and through our lives. When we yield to Him with unconditional trust and obey Him unconditionally to the altar of sacrifice, our obedience becomes our worship in action, through our love for Him. We will suddenly break through to His immense blessings.

Sometimes the Lord will tell us to do something that does not make sense at the time. This tests our wills, our minds and our emotions. When we choose to obey God regardlessly, God will do the impossible for us. Suddenly we will look back to the wonderful thing God has done.

Let us therefore yield to the Lord with unconditional surrender.
