## STEP OUT IN FAITH

Thank you all so much for your support during 2014 making it our best year so far! Your support has enabled over 30,000 evangelists to graduate this year, feed our orphans in Pakistan, enabled self-sufficiency in various countries and reached a huge number of people by radio in Africa.

**Revival** has broken out in various parts of Africa. In Kenya, under Joy Johnsons work, 2,200 prisoners came to the Lord and were baptised in a prison in Mombasa. It took all day for eleven pastors to baptise them all. Revival has also broken out in the refugee camps in Kenya and bible schools have been opened there. The students also did door to door evangelism every month as part of their studies and brought 18,310 people to the Lord between them.

**Breaking Through The Impossible With Christ:** In Sierra Leone, West Africa, Pastor Bobor has just completed two more journeys, one through central Sierra Leone and one to the South of Sierra Leone. This time not to take authority over Ebola Virus as there is none in the eleven towns where we took authority over the virus in Jesus' name. This time it was to encourage the Revival that has broken out as a result of the Lord delivering their towns from the deadly virus.

Most churches with a congregation of 50 people have grown to 150 or 200 people in two months. Almost daily I have spoken by phone to packed Gospel Crusades and by radio once or twice a day in those bigger towns that have radio stations. The people are so excited because they have all seen the great power of God over the Ebola Virus.

Pastor Bobor was also invited to Guinea, where he attached a speaker to a generator in his car and advertised a crusade for everybody to come to a certain selected field one hour later. Hundreds of people came. I gave the gospel message through the phone and an interpreter translated the message into French. Many people received Christ as a result. We then took authority over the Ebola Virus in that town.

On the way back from Guinea, Bobor's car had a broken back axle, so he had to walk the last ten miles. During the four days it took to get the axle fixed, I was able to preach over the radio twice a day to teach the basics of Christianity and spoke at a crusade every evening. This encouraged the Revival in that town.

Though the media is reluctant to report any good news, the people on the ground know that God has done it.


Dear Evangelist Suzanne,

I write to update you on the current situation of ebola in Magburaka since Pastor Emmanuel last visit and prayed for us though it is beyond my ethics as medical personnel. Like I told you yesterday on the phone, ebola is a national issue, that's why we do not make any press release until after 21 days of observation.

But however, the visit of the man of God really makes a change. Since his visit and the prayers you minister, there have been no cases. But before, we used to have 20-30 ebola cases to transfer to the epicenter in Kenema daily. I must confess that we medical people just administer treatment but it is God that heals. I want to take this opportunity to say thank you for good work God is using you to do.

I wish the program will be brought to us again.
