We were hoping that by the end of the year more prisons in Kenya would be opened to us to begin our Bible School. However, after only a six month trial of our Bible School in the Narok prison with 800 prisoners, we have been given the permission to start our Bible Schools in four more prisons in Kenya - at Kapenguria, Kitale, Eldoret and Nyeri. This is such wonderful news for us and also for the prisoners so we are expecting around 2000 prisoners to register for our one year school.

Even while we were rejoicing at this, God also opened to us a further five prisons in Uganda for us to begin teaching our Bible School. The expectation is that a further 2000 prisoners in Uganda will also register for our Bible School.

As I pondered God's words in **Ephesians Chap 3 Verse 20, "Now to Him who is able to do exceeding abundantly beyond all that we ask or think, according to the power that works within us."** The reality of this verse being applied to the prisons opening to us, caused me to be in awe and wonder at God's mighty power. He is an abundant God and all the praise and Glory go to Him.

In the orphan work we have been busy with the plastering of all the school buildings to bring them up to the new requirements of the Education Department, and also the finishing of the new dormitory we have been building at Hoima. All the orphans that have been sponsored received their 2nd terms books and pens and school fees were paid for them.

The tailoring Department at Hoima Vocational school are busy making next year's school uniforms for the children. So thank you to all the sponsors of the children for enabling so many orphans to have schooling.

May the Lord Bless You for standing with us in the Bible School work and all those who stand with us in caring for the orphans and widows side of the work. Please pray for the ministry, we really do value your prayers, especially as we start the new work in the prisons with all its challenges, and also for the ongoing work of our schools.
