He spent all day going from shop to shop but no success, until he had a divine appointment. He met one of his former Bible School students and he shared with him what he was looking for. This student knew a place that just specialised in making gowns. He took Chris there and the shop offered to make 50 gowns and supply the material for NZ 1,717.00. What a Blessing From God. How we all rejoiced together at God's provision.
